2. Use naloxone
3. Educate on addiction and stigma
4. Refer to treatment
5. Advocate for “on demand” treatment access
6. Advocate for treatment for those who are incarcerated or under community supervision
7. Prevent outbreaks
8. Consider fentanyl detection
9. Explore innovation
10. Support Good Samaritan laws
